SCHOOL UNIFORM AND PERSONAL PRESENTATION/GROOMING EXPECTATIONS

The school has established an excellent reputation over the years for the way in which our students present and conduct themselves in a range of situations, particularly in the public arena. This has occurred as a result of the partnership and cooperation between parents and the school. The support of parents for the school has been and will continue to be critical if these excellent standards are to be maintained.

The emphasis is on the students developing a sense of dignity and pride in themselves and in the school that they represent. We want our students to be modest and conservative and to wear their uniform with pride at all times.

The following is meant to clarify both the uniform requirements and personal grooming that is required of all students at Francis Jordan Catholic School.

School Uniform - General

- Children should wear their school uniform correctly, with a note of explanation if the correct uniform is unavailable.
- Hair standards are set for the students' safety and should avoid "excessive" display.
- Hair should be neatly combed or brushed, kept off the face and cut regularly.
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. These include Mohawk style cuts, and patterns cut into the hair. Cuts such as these will see the child sent to the Principal's office where they will await their parents to collect them in order to rectify the problem. The parent will return to the school with the child to meet with the Principal, prior to the child returning to class.
- Hair colours and tints are not permitted. Colouring of hair / tints will see the child sent to the Principal's office where they will await their parents to collect them in order to rectify the problem. The parent will return to the school with the child to meet with the Principal, prior to the child returning to class.
- Students with hair longer than collar length must have it tied back at all times with a hair tie in dark green or black.
- If students are using ribbons, headbands or elastic ties/scrunchies for hair, they must be dark green. Black bobby pins or dark green clips are acceptable.
- Braiding and beading in the traditional Bali style will be allowed to be kept in for one-week post-holiday.
- Shirts are to be tucked during class time, on arrival to school and returning home.

- School hats are to be worn before school, during recess, lunch, and Physical Education / Sport lessons. Where appropriate, the children should also wear a hat outside (e.g. Sports carnivals, outside classroom activities). School hats must be in good order with no 'graffiti' on them. If children do not have a hat at recess or lunchtime, they must stay in the shelter near the oval, the shelter outside the Year 1/2 classrooms or the shelter outside the Pre-Primary classrooms.
- Nail polish is never allowed.
- An analogue or digital watch is permitted.
- A maximum of one single stud / sleeper is permitted and must be worn in both ears. Studs or sleepers must be gold or silver in colour.
- Facial piercing is not permitted. Facial piercings will see the child sent to the Principal's office where they will await their parents to collect them in order to rectify the problem.
The parent will return to the school with the child to meet with the Principal, prior to the child returning to class.

In Winter, students participating in school photos and any public performance will be required to wear the following:

Green tights if wearing the skirt. Long trousers.

Ties are no longer needed – will be used on special occasions when the school will provide them.

PRE-PRIMARY / YEAR'S 1 AND 2 UNIFORM + SPORT UNIFORM FOR GIRLS & BOYS IN YEARS 3-6

Faction shirt or green school polo shirt

Black shorts with school name

PREDOMINATELY WHITE sandshoes or joggers (NOT BOOTS) **No fluorescent colours.**

Short white striped socks

Green school tracksuit

Green school hat – PLEASE NOTE that a school hat is required throughout the year.

OTHER ITEMS

Tracksuit – dark green colour. A tracksuit is not compulsory, however, if one is worn, then it must be the school tracksuit. **NO OTHER IS PERMITTED.**

SCHOOL BAG

Children are required to use the Francis Jordan Catholic school bag, which can only be purchased through the school's uniform shop.

VARIATIONS

1. The tracksuit top may be worn with the uniform. A note must provide when this circumstance occurs.
2. The school tracksuit top may be worn with the summer uniform.
3. The Rain Jacket sold by the Uniform Shop is the only rain jacket to be worn as part of the school uniform. It must not be worn as a substitute for the school jumper or tracksuit. It can be worn to and from school and at recess or lunch, but not during class.

In the event that the uniform is not being worn correctly, the teacher will speak to the child and communication will occur with the parent. Continued disregard for the uniform expectations will result in the issuing of a white slip.

The uniform changes will have a two-year phase in and will be compulsory as of the start of 2023
